DAWN

Ha. You're lucky I didn't shoot you. Never sneak up on a cop like that!

LUKE

AUSTIN  
I am now that mom let me slide on  
the tie! (Smiles)

LUKE  
Hey, now!

DAWN  
It's okay. Is TRUDY (33) up and  
ready?

LUKE  
Yup. She's ready to go. She has all

DAWN

#### EXT. STARLING POLICE DEPARTMENT

Everyone arrives to the outdoor gardens filled with blue chairs placed in rows. The square space is big enough to hold 2,500 people. It is filled with vibrant flower beds, a podium and a small stage. This is where all the honors take place in the department. Even the fallen.

Dawn's family, Austin, Luke, her father, FRANK HUDSON (50ish), ALANA HUDSON (36), her two boys, JACKIE BLAZE (35), her husband CHRIS and two boys, along with BONNIE MARTIN (33) her husband PAUL, her three kids are all in the front row.

PETER

Your extreme courage while facing imminent peril is beyond the call of duty. LT, come on up here!

ACT ONE

EXT. LAKESIDE MALL AREA

INT. POLICE SUV

Dawn glances over to Choo.

DAWN  
This sucks. I was supposed to go see my son's hockey game tonight after LUKE and I were going to go to dinner.

CHOO  
Just you and Luke?

DAWN  
He has a surprise for me. (she rolls her eyes). (sarcastically)  
You know how I just love surprises.

CHOO  
(chuckles) I know. Bad guys have no respect for people with schedules.

Dawn laughs as she continues to circle around the big tree that is on the other side of the barn. The tree is surrounded by a circular brick layout with rocks and red wood chips. The car narrowly missed the tree.

CHOO (cont'd)  
Hayes road is on this side, dude.

CUT TO:

INT. LUNA CAFE

Focus on a MIDDLE-AGED MALE and a teenage girl. Meet Firefighter JAMIE MCNEIL and his fifteen-year-old daughter CASSIE. They sit at her favorite table. The table is shaped like the moon. It bares a full giant moon on the table in gloss coating. the lamp above is also moon shaped and gives off the glow of the moon.

CASSIE  
I love this place!

JAMIE  
Me too.

KEVIN, the waiter greets them.

KEVIN  
Hey guys, long time no see!

JAMIE  
Yeah, been hectic.

KEVIN  
I know. Every time I hear sirens or  
see a fire truck pass by my house,  
I pray you and Hudson are going to  
be okay!

JAMIE  
Thanks bud! I'll have the pancake  
special! And a large OJ!

CASSIE  
The same!

KEVIN  
You got it!

Jamie's phone rings.

JAMIE

Hello?

ARSON (O.S.)

I'd like to see you get out of this  
one McNeil!

Jamie's eyes widen. He rises from the booth and screams to  
the people of the cafe.

JAMIE

Everyone, get out of here. Right  
now! Let's go!

As Kevin reaches the door to the kitchen, Jamie sprints over  
there and pulls him back.

JAMIE (cont'd)

We need everyone out, now!

KEVIN

What's going on?

JAMIE

This place is going to blow. Get  
everyone out!

The man on Jamie's phone is still there.

ARSON (O.S.)

I'm giving you two minutes to get  
everyone out. But, you need to  
stay!

JAMIE

(Laughing) Like hell I'll be  
staying.

ARSON (O.S.)

If you don't stay. Someone close to  
you burns! How about your brother?  
Mom, dad? That precious little girl  
of yours? How Dawn Hudson? Her son?  
Where is she, is she there with  
you?

JAMIE

No, she isn't.

ARSON (O.S.)

I want here there too! You two have  
meddled enough in my work!

JAMIE

I have no idea where Hudson is. She isn't here. What do you want?

ARSON (O.S.)

I want here there with you, now You need to make that happen.

An alert notification goes off on Jamie's phone. He receives a photo of Dawn's husband, Luke sitting at the kitchen table of her house. The caption reads, fire in five minutes.

JAMIE

You son of a...

ARSON (O.S.)

Ah, ah, ah, watch your tongue. Two minutes Captain! you better get Hudson here or... boom!

The call ends.

JAMIE

Two minutes, come on, everyone out, now! There's a bomb in here!

Everyone sits and ignores him. He hops on the bar that runs rectangular then curves. Jamie calls 9-1-1, then calls his firehouse.

Cassie begins to help people out. Perhaps they would listen to her.

JAMIE (cont'd)

Everyone out! Didn't you hear what I said? Get your shit and get out! There's a bomb in here! Ninety seconds! Come on!

CASSIE

My dad is a firefighter, everyone needs to get out. Come on!

Cassie helps people out. As everyone is out, she stays with him. He hops down from the counter and walks her to the door.

JAMIE

Don't worry. I'll be, okay! I promise. Deal?

CASSIE  
You better be! Deal! You need to  
call Dawn!

He nods to her and begins to call Dawn

DAWN (O.S.)  
Hudson?

JAMIE  
Huds, I need you at Luna Cafe asap.  
An arson is demanding you to come  
here. He's wired this to blow. I  
got two minutes to live!

DAWN (O.S.)  
What, on my way! I'm about five  
minutes out!

JAMIE  
Make it snappy!

The call ended. He called the Arson back.

JAMIE (cont'd)  
She's on her way, I swear it!

ARSON (O.S.)  
I know I saw and heard. I got  
cameras in there. You wait for her!  
Her family is on the line along  
with yours! Did you get the photos  
I sent you?

JAMIE  
I got the one of her husband  
sitting at the kitchen table in her  
house. Why did you send me that?

ARSON (O.S.)  
To remind you. I know you are  
friends. There are more photos  
coming. Respond when you get them.  
I'm extending your minutes you have  
left to live, Tick toc!

The call ends.

He sends Cassie out after talking with the Arson.

CUT TO:

CHOO

She climbs out of the SUV. Choo does the same. They draw their weapons and inspect the sidewalk leading up to the strip mall.

Dawn looks into the cafe through the double doors, she sees Jamie pacing. She calls him.

DAWN  
I'm here!

JAMIE (O.S.)  
I will text him. He more than

INT. LUNA CAFE

ARSON (O.S.)  
Tell her to come inside with you.  
You are lucky I allowed three more  
minutes for her to arrive. Tell her  
that her partner needs to wait  
outside.

The call ends. Jamie texts Dawn and he opens the door for her to enter.

Jamie opens the door for her and Dawn enters. He shows her the images the Arson sent her.

DAWN  
Who is this loon?

JAMIE  
I have no clue. But he knows about  
us. He knows everything about us!

DAWN  
Like?

JAMIE

He knows about Luke, Austin, Trudy,  
he knows about beth and Chris and  
their baby. He knows about Cassie.

DAWN

Who is this guy?

JAMIE

I don't know.

DAWN

Why only us?

JAMIE

I don't know that either.

DAWN

Is he planning to blow us up?

JAMIE

I think so. I know this place is  
rigged to blow. He waited extra  
time for you. I just wonder why he  
hasn't pulled the trigger yet.

Jamie phone rings. It's the Arson.

ARSON (O.S.)

Gotcha both! Get ready, he's  
coming, he's coming, that was for  
Hudson.

The call ends. Dawn shakes her head.

JAMIE

DAWN

I think he's quoting Prince.

JAMIE

Prince, what, why?

DAWN

Let's Go Crazy. Somehow he knows  
that's my song. But my new song is  
Lucifer from SHINee. Bet he doesn't  
know that. Give me your phone.

He hands her the phone. She calls the number the Arson has  
been calling from.

DAWN (cont'd)

Listen you son of a bitch. I do not negotiate with terrorists or assholes who think they can try and control me. Show yourself!

JAMIE

Now you done gone and made him mad, Huds. Don't do this!

DAWN

Answer me you bastard. Well, what say you? You chicken shit. Come on. You're so big and bad.

JAMIE

DAWN

ARSON (O.S.)

You certainly talk a big game. This is why I wanted you here, Hudson. I love your banter. I love how blunt you are. No filter and you are calling me out. I wanted to allow you both a chance to say goodbye.

END ACT ONE



ACT TWO

INT. LUNA CAFE MEN'S BATHROOM

Jamie blows out a few breaths. He and Dawn emerge from the stall and they both look around.

JAMIE

Thank the universe that bomb didn't touch the bathroom!

DAWN

No shit. What the hell McNeil, what kind of shit have you dragged me into?

JAMIE

Me?

DAWN

Yes, you! You called me here saying this dude wanted me here with you, why?

JAMIE

I, I don't know. This isn't my fault.

GARRET (O.S.)

Fire department, call out!

JAMIE

Garret! In the bathroom.

Jamie runs to the bathroom door but it's stuck. He pushes his left shoulder into it and it doesn't even budge. Dawn helps push the door but nothing.

JAMIE (cont'd)

Garret! In the bathroom! The men's bathroom! Door won't open!

GARRET (O.S.)

Fire department, call out!

JAMIE

Garret! Men's bathroom!

GARRET (O.S.)

I got something. I think it's Jamie. Men's bathroom. Come on guys!

The guys ferociously attempt to get the metal door open. After twenty minutes, they finally get the door open.

The door swings open.

GARRET

Man, I've never been happier to see your ugly mug!

Jamie hugs them all. Garret, Robert, and Troy.

JAMIE

Cassie, did everyone get out?

GARRET

They did. Cassie is safe. She's waiting for you outside!

JAMIE

INT. LUNA CAFE

Garret holds onto Jamie as they walk out the front of the cafe.

EXT. LUNA CAFE

Cassie runs from the other EMS personal that hold onto her.

CASSIE

Dad!

JAMIE

I'm good, sweetie. I'm good.

EMS PERSONAL 1

We're going to check you both out, just to be safe.

JAMIE

Okay, Rita! The guy, he was here. I saw him!

TROY

Did you get a good look at him?

JAMIE

He was parked, there, in a black car.

TROY

Can you remember what he looked like?

JAMIE

Yes. I never forget a face!

TROY

Dawn, are you okay?

DAWN

I'm okay.

As Jamie and Dawn are getting checked out, they see Luke, Trudy, and Austin run up to them all. Choo runs to them as well.

Austin runs right to Cassie. She hugs him.

AUSTIN

Dude, thought we lost you. We saw it all on the news!

CASSIE

Oh man, thank you for coming and caring.

Dawn glances to her son while Cassie holds onto him. Luke smirks.

LUKE

Dawn glances over her shoulder and shakes her head.

DAWN

INT. STARLING PD MAIN OFFICE

DAWN INTRODUCES JAMIE TO THEIR SKETCH ARTIST. CYNTHIA  
 THOMAS.

Jamie sits with her as the others tell them they will be in  
 Dawn's office.

INT. DAWN'S OFFICE

Austin, Cassie, and Luke sit in the visitor chairs. Dawn  
 sits behind her rectangular desk.

DAWN  
 So, you two like each other, huh?

Austin's cheeks blush. Cassie nods and her right leg bounces  
 up and down.

AUSTIN  
 Mom! We've only met online.

DAWN  
 A lot of um, relationships start  
 like that these days. I just can't  
 understand how whenever me and your  
 dad kiss, and do that kind of stuff  
 in front of you, you gross out but  
 yet we just learned about you two.

AUSTIN  
 Mom! You're embarrassing me!

He rises from the chair but her potent stare makes him sit  
 back down.

CASSIE  
(To Austin). My dad says you do  
that too. Is it true?

AUSTIN  
Only because they are my parents,  
you know. It's a boy thing. Now  
that I am embarrassed!

Austin pouts as he crosses his arms over his chest.

AUSTIN (cont'd)  
This is not fair! And who says we  
like each other um, that way. I  
like her as a hockey buddy!

CASSIE  
(Shocked, to Austin). Really,

AUSTIN

Cassie rises from her chair, runs to the door and walks out.  
Dawn nods to Luke. He goes after her.

AUSTIN (cont'd)

DAWN  
I was just asking. It was a

Austin pouts more. He looks out of the glass windows that  
surrounds Dawn's office at Luke consoling Cassie.

AUSTIN  
See what you did! Now I doubt  
she'll want anything to do with me!

DAWN  
Dude, you're only fourteen!

AUSTIN  
As a friend, mom. Only as a friend.

DAWN  
Apparently she wanted something  
more according to her dad.



AUSTIN

No way!

DAWN

Way!

AUSTIN

She never said anything. Man. You ruined it!

He rises from the chair and runs to the door. Dawn shakes her head and nods that perhaps he is right.

INT. OUTSIDE DAWN'S OFFICE

Austin walks to Cassie as she breaks from Luke.

LUKE

You two gonna be, okay?

AUSTIN

Yeah.

Luke goes back to Dawn's office.

AUSTIN (cont'd)

Cassie, hey, I had no idea. I'm only fourteen.

CASSIE

I know. But you are so very mature for fourteen!

AUSTIN

Yeah. I had to grow up fast when my dad vanished.

CASSIE

I know.

AUSTIN

Then he was killed.

CASSIE

I know. I saw my parents get killed too.

AUSTIN

Wait, what?

CASSIE

I wanted to talk to your mom about it. But then the explosion. Everything came rushing back. I, I need to go check on my dad.

AUSTIN

Hey, are you gonna be, okay?

Cassie starts crying. Austin holds her in his arms. For a fourteen year old, he sure acts like he's four years older.

AUSTIN (cont'd)

Holy shitballs! (She points to outside the office).

Luke turns around.

LUKE

Whoa! My boy!

DAWN

(Teary eyes) My boy is growing up!

Luke walks over to her and hugs her.

LUKE

Did you think he'd stay little forever?

DAWN

He's supposed to! He's my boy!

LUKE

Hey, if they really want to be together, I guess, they can.

DAWN

He's my boy! I don't know if I can handle this.

LUKE

Babe, it's obvious they've had this fling for a while now.

DAWN

He should have told me!

LUKE

He was probably scared. He's only fourteen.

DAWN

Yeah. I guess it was bound to happen.

Austin and Cassie enter the office.

DAWN (cont'd)

Everything, okay now?

AUSTIN

(Smiling) Yeah!

DAWN

Great. So, Cass, what are you and your dad doing today?

CASSIE

Well, after dinner, we were going to go to the beach.

DAWN

That sounds like fun.

CASSIE

Did you all want to join us?

DAWN

Depends on what beach?

CASSIE

Stony Creek I think.

DAWN

Well, I'm off today. (She looks to Luke. He nods). Sounds great then! We should go check on your dad.

INT. STARLING PD MAIN OFFICE

They all enter the main room of the station. Jamie is just finishing up.

DAWN  
(To Cynthia) What have we got?

Cynthia shows her the sketch.

CYNTHIA  
Does anyone know this guy?

DAWN  
I um, no. I don't. (Dawn shows the sketch to Luke and the others).

They all shake their heads no.

DAWN (cont'd)  
Well, we got our first lead on this guy. Put it to all the news stations. I need to make a call.

Dawn leaves.

JAMIE  
Can you put that in the computer and find out who this guy is?

CYNTHIA  
Yes we can. (Smiles to him).

Luke, Austin, and Cassie notice the smile. And Cynthia's eyes beaming at Jamie.

JAMIE  
Thanks. Well, are we still up for the beach then?

LUKE  
Yeah, Austin, you want to go to the beach?

AUSTIN  
Yeah! But I do have a game tonight at eight pm.

LUKE  
Right. You guys want to come to Austin's game?

CASSIE

Yes!

JAMIE

(laughing). Okay, it's a date then!

Dawn returns.

DAWN

I got a name!

CYNTHIA

You beat the computer!

DAWN

Yeah. I know a reporter or two.

CYNTHIA

What's the name?

DAWN

MARK BODINE!

Dawn looks to Jamie and shakes his head no that he doesn't know this guy.

DAWN (cont'd)

If you don't know him, why is he signaling you out then?

JAMIE

I don't know.

DAWN

What other places has he hit, does he a rap sheet, Cynthia?

CYNTHIA

Let me check.

She types the guy's name into the computer. A few moments later, report comes out of the machine next to her computer.

DAWN

Holy crap. This guy has a sheet five miles long almost. Look at this, targeting firefighters, targeting police, and EMS personal.

JAMIE

He has a beef with all first responders?

DAWN  
Looking like.

JAMIE  
Well, we have a name, and now we  
know.

Jamie's walkie talkie goes off.

TROY (O.S.)  
(on walkie)  
Jamie, you there?

JAMIE  
Here boss, what's up.

TROY (O.S.)  
(on walkie) I've been informed you  
got the night and the next day off.  
To heal and rest.

JAMIE  
Thanks boss.

END ACT TWO

ACT THREE

INT. RESTAURANT - EVENING NEXT DAY.

Fancy, eloquent but modern. Dawn is wearing a gray power suit. Luke is wearing Armani, black. They walk towards a YOUNG WOMAN at the podium.

LUKE

Table for two, the name is  
Harrington.

HOSTESS

Oh! My! GOSH! Mr. Harrington, sir,  
Um, right this way, sir!

Dawn shakes her head and gives the woman a stern glare. Luke notices.

DAWN

Wow, you still get the sir and  
woman drooling. I feel so guilty  
about this!

LUKE

Why do you feel guilty?

DAWN

Because. Jacob is in the hospital  
and I'm out with another man. We  
shouldn't do this!

LUKE

Look, I know this is weird but this  
date has been planned before you  
found him. I had to reserve this  
day two months in advance. Still  
feel guilty?

DAWN

Maybe a little.

LUKE

(sighing) Like only basically a  
little? (chuckles)

DAWN

(Laughing) Well, basically, not  
even a word, which I hate, yeah!  
(laughing)

LUKE

Well, you don't need to be! We are still married. Jacob was declared dead. And until he gets out of the hospital, there's nothing he can do right now.

DAWN

What are you saying?

LUKE

I'm saying we are still legally married. You can still act like we are. Until Jacob is ready to come back, we can still be together.

The young woman seats them at a table by the main window up front near the entrance. Other patrons are conversing near and around them.

DAWN

Wow. This is such a fancy place.  
What's the special occasion?

Luke pulls out a seat for Dawn. She sits. He sits in his.

As they overlook the menus the hostess handed them, Dawn is sitting across from Luke and can see the front double doors. Many people are coming and going. But two PECULIAR MEN catch her hazel green eyes.

LUKE

I know you have a big day planned for your fourteenth year on the force, but I wanted to do something special for you. Just you and me. Babe?

DAWN

Call 9-1-1. A couple of dudes dressed in all black about to do bad things!

The Man on the right shows an automatic weapon after whisking his long black trench coat to the back side of him.

A few shots go off.

MAN 1

Everybody FREEZE! My associate will be around to collect all your cell phones. And I hope to God, nobody called 9-1-1!



Just as Luke hits send on his phone, he sighs and shakes his head. He glances across to Dawn.

LUKE  
(whispers) Too late. What do we do now?

DAWN  
Nothing now. Do not led on that I'm a cop. I'll think of something.

MAN 2 pulls out a white pillow case from his back pocket and begins to go to all the tables. He walks to Dawn and Luke's table.

MAN 2  
Phones! NOW!

Luke nods his head as does Dawn. Before Man 2 leaves, he goes back to them.

MAN 2 (cont'd)  
Boss! We got a couple of celebrities tonight! It's Former Deputy Chief of Staff for SENATOR DAN BOGDAN and Starling Pd's own, Lieutenant Dawn Hudson!

MAN 1  
Woot! We struck it big time tonight T-Man!

Man 1 walks over to Luke and Dawn's table.

MAN 1 (cont'd)  
Well, lookeey what we have here. This is just awesome. You two are worth more than what anybody can give us in here! Come with me!

Luke rises from his chair with his hands up. Dawn reaches down to scratch her right ankle. She pulls a baby Glock and shoots Man 1 in the shoulder, then shoots man 2 in the leg.

MAN 1 (cont'd)  
BITCH!

She rises from her chair and kicks their weapons away. She cuffs Man 1 and stays by man 2 who is lying on the floor, screaming in pain. She digs for her phone and calls 9-1-1.

MAN 1 (cont'd)  
You will pay for this, BITCH! I  
will get you one day for this!

Luke walks over to her and kicks the man who is down on his  
knees in the face.

LUKE  
Don't call my woman that!

MAN 1  
Oh yeah? I'm pressing charges  
against you Mr. Former Deputy!  
That's right! I got you!

Dawn grabs her phone and calls 9-1-1.

DAWN  
Yeah, I got an armed robbery,  
burglary attempt at the Blue  
Tempest restaurant! This is  
Starling PD Lieutenant Dawn Hudson  
of the Burglary, Crime, & Property  
Scene unit!

9-1-1 OPERATOR (O.C.)  
Sending Ambo and backup to you now  
LT!

Luke stands in awe at his wife saving the day. She walks  
over to him and checks him out.

DAWN  
Are you, okay?

LUKE  
I am. Babe, that was just, WOW!  
Totally amazing! I just...

Other patrons walk up to her to give their thanks. Even the  
OWNER, DON SWANSON (50s).

DON  
Thank you. Thank you so very much  
Mrs. Hudson. You saved us! You  
saved a lot of people tonight!

DAWN  
Just doing my job.

DON  
You were here for dinner?

DAWN

I was, with my husband, over there.  
(She points to Luke).

DON

I see. Well, your next meal is on  
me! And in the future as well.

DAWN

Thank you, sir but that's not  
necessary. I'm just a cop. Any  
other cop would have done the same!

Backup arrives, she sees her partner, Choo. He runs right up  
to her. He is followed by the rest of the team.

Dawn explains what happened. Stephanie and Chris take the  
bad guys away.

CEIF OF POLICE MARIE PATERSON enters with the others.

MARIE

Wow Huds, another win for the  
Starling PD.

DAWN

Yeah, was just trying to have  
dinner.

MARIE

Well, I guess I can wait on the  
report.

DAWN

Really? I mean, we can give Choo  
our statements and he could write  
it.

CHOO

I could write what?

DAWN

Our statements on what happened  
here tonight. I um, was having  
dinner and it got rudely  
interrupted.

CHOO

I see. (chuckles) You allergic to  
paperwork?

DAWN

(Laughing) I am.

CHOO

Um, okay then. I guess that's what I do now. I'm a cop who writes my boss' reports and stuff.

DAWN

(laughs) Yeah and you're good at it. Your penmanship is just wow.

After an hour or so, the police left and Luke and Dawn were able to have their dinner.

LUKE

So, where were we?

DAWN

I think about to order.

LUKE

Right.

Luke calls for their waiter and puts in their order. He pulls out a black rectangular velvet box and smiles at Dawn.

He gives her the box. She opens it. She smiles wide. Inside the box is a pendant of gold cuffs engraved with the year she joined the force and her name. The cuffs are attached to an eighteen inch solid gold rope chain.

LUKE (cont'd)

You have cuffed my heart since we reconnected. even though we need to separate, I still wanted to give you something special. I'm not giving you my pressure. I know you made your choice. But just know, I'll always be here for you guys.

She wipes slight tears from her eyes. He gets off the chair, walks to her, grabs the necklace and puts the chain around her neck.

LUKE (cont'd)

There. It's official. I didn't know what to get you. But I did some research.

DAWN

It's amazing. I had no idea about any of this! Thank you!

LUKE

It's been magical while it lasted.  
This may just be our final date and  
I wanted to go out with a bang. And  
that almost literally just  
happened. (he laughs)

DAWN

And harrowing. (laughs)

LUKE

Yeah.

DAWN

Sorry to have put you through all  
that.

LUKE

It's okay. But do you think those  
guys will be a new problem for you?  
The guys who tried to rob this  
place?

DAWN

They always threaten me. I'm just  
so used to it. If anything happens,  
just know the department will have  
our backs, no matter what.

LUKE

I know you chose Jacob, once  
everything settled from that. I  
promised you I would step aside.  
But I still love you, Huds. I don't  
know if I can just step aside so  
easily.

DAWN

I know. We have a long difficult  
road ahead of us.

INT. STARLING PD HEADQUARTERS - OFFICE RECEPTION AREA - NEXT  
DAY

Lieutenant Dawn Hudson stands at the desk talking with  
VERONICA BENTLEY (20s). Sleek, keeps herself well. Stern  
voice.

DAWN

Have anything for for me, Roni?

VERONICA

Marie wants to see you in her office.

DAWN

Oh? Did she say what this is about?

VERONICA

Nope. But I heard about last night. I actually saw it on the TV. You were amazing, as always.

DAWN

Yeah. Okay then, see you.

VERONICA

Yup, see you!

Dawn leaves the area and walks down a hallway, turns left, then a right to the Chief's office.

INT. CHIEF OF POLICE OFFICE

Marie waves Dawn in. Dawn opens the single glass door and enters. Her eyes widen at seeing the Mayor of Starling: PAMELA MORRIS (40s).

MARIE

Hudson, well, I'm glad you're on time today.

Dawn shakes hand with the Mayor. Dawn takes a visitor chair to her left, the Mayor sits in the one to Dawn's right.

DAWN

So, is this about me?

PAMELA

(Looks over to Marie) Did you tell her already?

MARIE

No. I didn't get the chance.

PAMELA

Yes. This is about you. LT. What you did last night, was amazing. The media is eating it up.

DAWN

Um, what?

Pamela pulls out a manila folder and flips it open. She puts out a handful of newspapers on the glass square table between them.

PAMELA

Look at these. The Free Press, top cop takes out armed men, saves people. The Starling Press, top cop saves many citizens. New York Times! Washington Post. Los Angeles Times. USA Today, Chicago Tribune.

DAWN

(Sighs) Look, I was just doing my job.

PAMELA

It was like those kids filming you in the apartment building. You saved that boy's life. I know the media has been wrapped up with you since then, right?

DAWN

Not really. Look, I just want to do my job. I don't want any of this.

PAMELA

Huds, may I call you Huds?

DAWN

Sure.

PAMELA

If you think this is going to go away, it isn't. The nation is taken with you. you found your missing husband. This story is just amazing. Like a fairy tale. The world is loving it.

DAWN

Yeah and I bet other cops can't stand me.

PAMELA

Actually, a lot of the cops are saying great things too. Look, I think this could be great for the nation. You know how in many parts of the nation, people are against cops. If you start with this, think of all the good that come from it.

DAWN

No. My family has enough to deal with me being famous. I will not subject them to this.

PAMELA

I also have contract offers.

Pamela pulls out a few contract offers and lays them on the table.

DAWN

(Shakes head) Seriously? T-Mobile, Pepsi, Jets Pizza, Verizon, Rebok, Miller Lite, Dr. Pepper? I mean, I wouldn't mind a life time supply of the last two but, Pam, no way. I'm not some Miss Congeniality. I don't want to make a mockery of the uniform.

PAMELA

You take anyone of those offers and you're set for life.

DAWN

I just want to be a cop. Marie, is there anything else?

MARIE

(Looks to Pamela) I have nothing for you. Choo is waiting for you in your office.

DAWN

What about the perps from last night?

MARIE

They spent the night waiting for their lawyers.

PAMELA

Huds, just think about it, okay?

DAWN

Can you really force me into this?

PAMELA

I don't want to force anyone into anything they won't be happy with. But Huds, think of what you can do with this, for the uniform. This

(MORE)



PAMELA (cont'd)  
could be exactly what the nation  
needs. You know, to feel better  
about the police.

DAWN  
I'll think about it.

PAMELA  
Here, take a look at some of these  
contracts. Read the articles. Talk  
with your family. I need a reply by  
Friday.

DAWN  
Um, what? Friday?

PAMELA  
Yeah. All these contracts, they  
want a reply by then.

DAWN  
Um, okay then.

Dawn leaves the office.

INT. HALLWAY

Dawn leans her head against the office door. She closes her  
eyes.

DAWN (V.O.)  
What a shit storm now. I just, mom,  
what should I do?

She laughs and heads out. She arrives at her office, opens  
the door and sees Choo sitting in one of the visitor chairs.

INT. DAWN'S OFFICE

Dawn's office has a large glass window to where she can see  
the Detectives room adjacent to her right. On the walls,  
Dawn sports her awards, her certificates of graduation from  
the police Academy, and honors. This doesn't mean she's a  
show off. It was her oldest sister's idea, Alana.

Her desk is immaculate. Not a speck of dust anywhere. Sort  
of a neat freak.

CHOO  
Hey, boss, what's up?

DAWN

I was going to ask you. So, I heard our guys lawyered up, huh?

CHOO

They did.

DAWN

No matter. Shall we go have a chat with them?

CHOO

So, nothing is up? Like nothing?

DAWN

(Gasps) You know, you know about my meeting with the Mayor, right?

CHOO

I do. It's all over, Huds. What are you going to do?

DAWN

Go talk to our perps. End of story.

CHOO

Gotcha. Let's go. I'll call OFFICER LINDA HUXLEY to have them brought into the interrogation room.

DAWN

I want them separate.

CHOO

Okay, gotcha.

DAWN

Choo, go set it up. I'll be there in a few minutes. I just need a few minutes, okay.

CHOO

Hey, you, okay?

DAWN

Yeah. I just need a few minutes, okay. I'll be there.

CHOO

Okay, gotcha.

She watches Choo leave her office. She pulls out her cell phone and the first person she calls is her husband. He answers on the first ring.

LUKE (O.C.)  
Hey, babe, everything, okay?

DAWN  
(Sighs) how are things there?

LUKE (O.C.)  
All quiet. What's wrong?

DAWN  
Did you see the papers this morning yet?

LUKE (O.C.)  
I have the morning news on. And yeah. All they are talking about is last night. What's going on?

DAWN  
I got way more than just that. The Mayor was here. She wants me to do some um, public relations and there are some contracts.

LUKE (O.C.)  
Um, what contracts?

DAWN  
Yeah. Look, be careful today. Tell Trudy and Austin the same. It might get crazy.

LUKE (O.C.)  
What are you saying?

DAWN  
I can't talk about all of it right now. I have to work. But we will talk later, I promise. Just be extra careful today.

LUKE (O.C.)  
Okay babe. I love you, no matter what!

DAWN

Yeah, okay. Luke, I do love you but  
if I don't say it much, you know  
why.

LUKE

I do. I know it's hard right now.  
I'm sorry if I'm saying it too  
much.

DAWN

Don't blame yourself, it's okay.

The call Ends. Dawn locks her office.

INT. HALLWAY

Dawn walks the hallways toward the interrogation rooms. She  
calls her dad and her three sisters. She leaves voice mails  
for them all to be careful.

She arrives at the interrogation room and takes a deep  
breath. Choo is waiting for her outside.

END ACT THREE

ACT FOUR

INT. INTERROGATION ROOM MID-MORNING

Dawn and Choo enter. She sees the first man sitting quietly with his hand cuffed. The other cuff is attached to the metal bar that sits an inch or two above the metal table. She eyes the sophisticated man sitting next to him wearing Armani, black with a red, white, and blue tie.

LAWYER

Hello, Lieutenant, Detective, my name is MARTIN THOMPSON and I will be representing Mr. CHUCK MELINSKI.

DAWN

Okay.

Dawn opens the file folder in front of her that she tossed to the table when she entered. She sees Chuck's photo paper clipped to the top left corner. She sees his rap sheet that extends beyond five pages.

DAWN (cont'd)

I see you have a rap sheet here that's pretty long.

CHUCK

Listen here, bitch!

MARTIN

Chuck, I suggest you calm down. And not say a word.

DAWN

I'd like to hear what other colorful language he has to call me. Please, let him continue.

MARTIN

What my client is saying, there is no evidence of him being at the Blue Tempest restaurant on the day in question.

DAWN

Oh no? My team investigated. We have the security camera footage of him and his partner outside just twenty-minutes prior. They were out back in the alley getting ready.

Dawn grabs the five photos from the folder and places them in front of Chuck and Martin.

DAWN (cont'd)  
My team is thorough, Mr. Thomson.  
So, there's nothing your client can say.

CHUCK  
Did you talk to, MATHEW?

DAWN  
Is that your partner?

CHUCK  
Yes.

DAWN  
No, not yet. He's next on my list.

CHUCK  
Okay, okay, I want a deal! Can you get me a deal?

DAWN  
I'm afraid not. We got you dead to rights. Both of you.

MARTIN  
So, there is nothing you can do, Lieutenant?

DAWN  
I'm afraid not. Unless this leads to something bigger? But if it's just the two of you, then there's nothing.

CHUCK  
What if I can get you a bigger name?

MARTIN  
I suggest you do nothing.

CHUCK  
SHUT UP! I want a deal. I want out of this rat race! You know nothing. There is a bigger person.

DAWN  
Give me a name. If it checks out, I may come back with a deal for you.

CHUCK  
May? I need more than a may for  
this name, bitch!

DAWN  
You best stop calling me that if  
you want a deal!

CHUCK  
Fine. The name is, MARK BODINE!

DAWN  
(Eyes widen) WHOA! Mark Bodine? Are  
you sure?

CHUCK  
Yes!

DAWN  
I find that hard to believe!

CHUCK  
Check it out. If you find it's  
true, I want a fucking deal!

DAWN  
I'll check your story out. This  
interrogation is over, for now. I  
still need to talk to Mathew. If  
you want, write it all down.

Dawn slides a legal notepad across the table and hands him a  
pen. Martin looks on in disbelief.

Dawn and Choo leave the room.

INT. OUTSIDE INTERROGATION ROOM

CHOO  
Wow!

DAWN  
I know right.

CHOO  
So, these guys work for Mark?  
What's the angle here?

DAWN  
Choo, I want you to look into him.  
Discretely if you can.

CHOO

Me boss? I'm not a hacker or anything like that.

DAWN

Just look into him. But do not let him know about it. Look into his financials, his life.

CHOO

But boss, under what grounds?

DAWN

You saying you want me to go to Peter with this before we question Mathew?

CHOO

Yes.

DAWN

(Sighs) Seriously?

CHOO

Yes!

DAWN

Fine, I'll go ask him, then you can interview Mathew. Take Rohan with you.

CHOO

But...

DAWN

No buts. It's either you interview Mathew or look into Mark.

CHOO

Gee, those are my choices?

DAWN

Yup.

CHOO

Fine. I'll go find Rohan.

Rohan, is the sergeant of the team. He is of Mohican descent. Not much is known about him.

Dawn leaves him and heads to Peter's office. She stops at the wall of fallen heroes.



## INT. WALL OF FALLEN HEROES

Dawn sees all the gold stars on the rectangular wall. She sees her mom's name in the middle. SAMANTHA CYNTHIA HUDSON. Dawn places her fingers over the star. She checks both ways and she is alone.

DAWN

I miss you mom. I got quite the delima. I'm sure you know about what Pam wants me to do. I'm not that type of woman! I can't do that. I never wanted to. What do I do mom?

She continues to rub the star.

OFFICER WILLIAM BAKER

Hey, Huds, you, okay?

DAWN

Oh, hey, Will. Yeah. Just had to stop for a moment.

He sees her fingers on Samantha Hudson's star.

OFFICER WILLIAM BAKER

Oh. I um, well, Choo and Rohan are finished with interviewing Mathew.

DAWN

Oh, already? They get anything?

OFFICER WILLIAM BAKER

No. The dude wouldn't budge.

DAWN

Okay then. I need to head to Peter's office.

OFFICER WILLIAM BAKER

Okay, I'll see you around.

DAWN

Yeah.

She leaves him and heads towards Peter's office. She arrives and sighs just before she knocks on the door.

Dawn knocks on the door and Peter waves her in.

INT. PETER'S OFFICE

Dawn sits in the first visitor chair.

PETER BROWN  
What've you got?

DAWN  
Mark Bodine. The guys confirmed it.  
He's the same Mark Bodine that  
caused the fire at the cafe. He has  
a wrap sheet, boss. And it's all  
against first responders.

PETER  
I see.

DAWN  
What do you want us to do, boss?

PETER  
Well, the cafe was a break-in,  
right?

DAWN  
Yup.

PETER  
So, that makes this guy ours, for  
now. I want you to finish up  
questioning Mathew. Then, you and  
your team go to Mark's house. I'll  
push a warrant for you.

DAWN  
Boss?

PETER  
This guy is ours, Huds! I want him.

DAWN  
Okay, then.

PETER  
Check in when you are done.

DAWN  
Gotcha!

INT. PRECINCT HALLWAY

Dawn takes a few turns to head back to her office.

INT. DAWN'S OFFICE

She unlocks the door and enters. Dawn walks to her desk, sits down in the black leather chair and puts her feet up.

DAWN

Mark Bodine. This makes no sense.  
But I get why Peter is having us  
talk to him. If he is part of this  
break-in, Peter is right, he is  
ours.

A knock on her door brings her out of her thoughts. She looks through the glass and sees it's Choo and her Sergeant. She waves them in.

DAWN (cont'd)

What do you guys got?

ROHAN

Nothing from Mathew.

CHOO

What did Peter say?

DAWN

We need to go question Bodine.

CHOO

Um what?

DAWN

Yeah. I'm just waiting on Peter to  
give us the warrant.

CHOO

Yeah but Chuck is waiting on his  
deal.

DAWN

We go back to him after we check  
out Mark's place.

ROHAN

Boss, do you think this is a trap?

DAWN

No way! Why would Peter do this to us?

ROHAN

I'm not talking about Peter. I mean this whole thing with this Mark guy and that firefighter, Jamie.

DAWN

Why would that be a trap?

ROHAN

You said that he's been targeting first responders of all types in this state.

DAWN

I know. I don't know. We need to find out.

CHOO

Huds, you sure you want to go down this road?

DAWN

We have no choice.

They leave the station. Dawn gets a call on her walkie talkie that sits next to her phone on the dash.

CENTRAL DISPATCHER (O.S.)

We have a reckless driver driving near the Fifteen Mile Road. The warehouse district.

Dawn and the team sigh. They rush out of the building to her SUV.

A few moments later, they are on the tail of the suspect after another officer had them on their tail.

INT. DAWN'S SUV

DAWN

Officer, we are your backup, status?

OFFICER DAPHNE CRUZ (O.S.)

Hey Huds, this is Tracy Brown. I'm at the main warehouse on fifteen mile road, I lost him.

DAWN  
Shit. We are thirty seconds away. I  
see you. I see the warehouse.

Dawn is behind the gray car. Daphne pulls up and pit  
maneuvers the car. The person stops and Dawn and her team  
backup Tracy as she arrests the middle-age man.

OFFICER DAPHNE CRUZ  
Is this him? (To Dawn)

DAWN  
Nope. Damn it!

MIDDLE-AGED MAN  
What is the meaning of this?

OFFICER DAPHNE CRUZ  
Sir, you were driving recklessly.  
I'm arresting you for reckless  
driving and endangerment of others.

The man sighs. Daphne puts him the back of her cruiser.

CUT TO:

EXT. MARK BODINE'S HOME LATER THAT NIGHT - SAME DAY

DAWN  
(into her walkie talkie) Everyone  
ready?

Everyone nods. Dawn knocks on the front door.

DAWN (cont'd)  
Starling PD! We have a warrant to  
search the premises! Mark Bodine!  
Starling PD!

No answer.

Dawn peaks through the side glass pane to the right of the door. She shakes her head at her team. Stephanie and Christopher are the right side of the door.

Choo and Rohan are on the left, Dawn is to the left too.

DAWN (cont'd)  
Mark Bodine! Starling PD! Open up.  
We have a warr...

Dawn and her team are thrown from the blast of fire that engulfs the front of the home. Dawn is thrown onto the lawn of the neighbor's house. Choo, Rohan, are thrown near her. Stephanie and Christopher are thrown on the other lawn.

She quickly comes to and grabs her shoulder mic.

DAWN (cont'd)  
(into walkie  
talkie)  
Everyone check in! Choo! Rohan,  
Steph, Chris!?

No answer.

DAWN (cont'd)  
(into walkie  
talkie)  
Everyone check in! Choo! Rohan,  
Steph, Chris!?

A sudden cough comes over her mic.

DAWN (cont'd)  
I hear you, who is coughing?

CHOO  
It's, me, boss.

DAWN  
You guys, okay?

CHOO  
Rohan and I are, okay.

DAWN  
Steph? Chris?

CHRIS  
Chris here, we're good!

DAWN  
Coming over to you now!

Dawn, Rohan, and Choo get to their feet. They make their way to Chris and Stephanie.

CHRIS  
I want this guy!

DAWN  
We'll get him!

Dawn's cb radio goes off with a male voice from central.

CENTRAL DISPATCHER (O.S.)  
Lieutenant Hudson, Chopper seven just spotted our suspect fleeing from a residential fire. He is heading toward the Starling garage parking area on Fifteen Mile and Van Dyke.

DAWN  
Ten four. On my way central.

Dawn arrives at the garage. Her team is there with a police cruiser. She hops in. They see the SUSPECT, young male, short brown hair, as he is running from them. They drive slowly toward him. He turned around and fires at them.

DAWN (cont'd)  
Central, Rohan, Choo, and I are giving chase.

The man fires back at them. Dawn pulls her taser and the man falls down. Rohan and Choo arrest him. After many moments, he comes too. They take him to the car.

DAWN (cont'd)  
Mark Bodine?

SUSPECT  
Screw you pig!

Rohan digs in the man's back pocket, finds a wallet. He opens it and smiles at Dawn.

ROHAN  
We got him!

They arrive back at the station and before they walk in, Dawn smiles at seeing a familiar face.

LIEUTENANT CHARLOTTE RINNING is stand outside with Jamie McNeil.

DAWN

Jamie! Char! We got this guy!

CHARLOTTE

Awesome, way to go guys.

DAWN

What's wrong Char?

CHARLOTTE

It's my Dad. He's not doing to well. I know I was supposed to be off but, Dawn, I need you and your team.

DAWN

What's going on?

CHARLOTTE

I think someone broke into my dad's house tried to kill him!

DAWN

Wow, do you have proof of this?

CHARLOTTE

Yeah, but he has a ABT camera system and they are refusing to release the tapes. I need your help.

DAWN

Okay, you got it. Is PAUL going to be okay? You should be with him.

CHARLOTTE

I want to be but they told me I couldn't right now. Dawn, I think this might be a tie into your guy there.

MARK

I do not know you you or your dad are.

Charlotte walks up to him and grabs him by his chest, pulling some hairs with her fist. He screams like a little girl.



CHARLOTTE
